Notification – Death of a Retired UFOA Member By Patrick Reynolds



Retired UFOA members will leave the task of notification of your death to family members. You do not really have a choice, right? This task, during a difficult time will be eased if you have prepared and collated information in a central location.

Also, you have told other family members where to find this information. To assist our UFOA retirees and families, a check list is provided as this would relate to your status as a FDNY retiree and UFOA member. Notifications that may be required with other entities such as your financial institutions, social security, the Veterans Administration, utility/cable/phone companies etc. will be unique to each individual and will require you to add these items to the checklist provided.

Information regarding the Deferred Compensation Plan and the Health Benefits is found on the OLR website.

The death certificate will be the most important document for family members to have when navigating the various notifications that will need to be made. Requesting a dozen or more certified original copies at the time of death is prudent. Some organizations may accept a photo copy or scan. Others may require an original to be mailed which is usually returned. Having extra copies left over is better than trying to obtain more at a later date.

The primary notification should be to the FDNY Operations center (FDOC).

Using the check list provided, have as much information prepared in advance of the notification. Phone: 718 999 7900. Indicate that you are making a death notification of a retired member.

The FDNY ceremonial unit will provide an escort for retirees in the New York State counties that active members are legally allowed to live. World Trade Center (WTC) deaths that occur in retirement are also provided an escort.

To contact the ceremonial unit, call 718 281 3864, fax 718 281 3334

The second notification is to the UFOA-FPP. All retirees have a life insurance policy that is provided by the UFOA. If you are 70 years old and over, a \$2,000.00 policy is payable upon death. In addition, the FPP staff will mail out an information packet for your survivor to review. In some cases, health coverage and FPP benefits will continue for the spouse if the death is related to the Heart, Lung or WTC. A retiree would have had to retire under the heart bill or lung bill. Only WTC deaths can be reclassified at the time of death if not previously disabled for the ailment.

The third notification will be to the Fire Pension Fund. Pension payments when received are for the previous month. When a member dies during the month, if a timely notification is made, a prorated pension check will be paid. Over payments will be returned to the pension fund. If a survivor option exists, the pension will be adjusted accordingly.

Additionally, a life insurance policy is managed by the Pension fund. The current face value is \$7,500.00 (as of July 2020).
